Accessibility

These checks highlight opportunities to [improve the accessibility of your web app](#). Only a subset of accessibility issues can be automatically detected so manual testing is also encouraged.

ARIA

▲ Elements with an ARIA `[role]` that require children to contain a specific `[role]` are missing some or all of those required children. ▼

▲ ARIA input fields do not have accessible names ▼

These are opportunities to improve the usage of ARIA in your application which may enhance the experience for users of assistive technology, like a screen reader.

CONTRAST

▲ Background and foreground colors do not have a sufficient contrast ratio. ▼

These are opportunities to improve the legibility of your content.

NAVIGATION

▲ `[id]` attributes on active, focusable elements are not unique ▼

These are opportunities to improve keyboard navigation in your application.

NAMES AND LABELS

▲ Links do not have a discernible name ▼

○ No form fields have multiple labels ▼

These are opportunities to improve the semantics of the controls in your application. This may enhance the experience for users of assistive technology, like a screen reader.

TABLES AND LISTS

▲ Lists do not contain only `` elements and script supporting elements (`<script>` and `<template>`). ▼

These are opportunities to improve the experience of reading tabular or list data using assistive technology, like a screen reader.
